
WHEREAS: the NWA Democratic Black Caucus may operate as a staple station in Northwest Arkansas to enhance the quality of life for both locals and transplants,

Eleanor Roosevelt, and Julianna Roosevelt**


and encourage all citizens to support the efforts of the NWA Democratic Black Caucus in any way possible to ensure the success of this organization and those they serve.
